Project Information

Description: The Children's Home Society's Foster Care Program provides shelter for children (ages newborn through 17). Our needs are diapers, sizes 1 through 4, pull-ups, baby wipes, baby lotions & shampoos, new clothing 3mos through 3T. Children usually enter into foster care with very little babies come into care with no baby supplies. Diapers continue to be our biggest need to assist foster parents caring for these children.

Volunteers will collect items described above.

Who will benefit: Infants and toddlers placed in Foster care by the courts because of abuse, neglect or abandonment. Diapers continue to be the biggest need to assist foster parents caring for these children and caseworkers working with families in crisis.

Long Term Impact: The care and nurturing of newborns and toddlers in safe and child friendly environment. This project continues to be essential to the care of our infants and toddlers in the CHS foster program. Diapers are not covered in reimbursement by the State and a foster parent receives only \$17.00 per day to provide for the baby.
