Project Information

Description: The 9th Annual Old Enterprise Festival is a community event that raises funds for the Enterprise Heritage Center Project. This project is restoring the historic Old Enterprise Schoolhouse on Main Street to be used as a museum and community center. The festival is also a showcase for local folk, bluegrass and traditional musicians and a gathering of the Enterprise community.

Volunteers may be asked to sell tickets for various games, help to serve food and keep dining areas clean, help with setting up shade canopies, vendor booths, stage and sound equipment, etc.

Who will benefit: All of the residents of Enterprise, an unincorporated area of Volusia County, benefit from the festival and will benefit from the opening of the Heritage Center. The estimated population of Enterprise and the approximate number of festival attendees is about 2,000.

Long Term Impact: The festival Benefits the Enterprise Heritage Center Museum Project, which will serve as a local history museum and community center and will host many educational and conservation programs for many years to come.
