The purpose is to achieve both permanent housing and self-sufficiency.

Project Information

Description: We need our building walkways and staircases pressure cleaned and we need landscaping in the front and back of our facility in Daytona Beach.

Who will benefit: Our resident parents and children will benefit from the cleanliness of the stairs and walkways and the beauty of the landscaping. And, obviously, staff, board, volunteers, visitors and passersby will enjoy the plants and flowers.

Long Term Impact: Self esteem is one of the first things families lose when they're under stress and either face homelessness or actually become homeless. When they move into our program and into their fully furnished apartment, are sent to our Secret Attic Thrift Stores for clothing, and begin meeting weekly with their case manager, they learn that someone cares about them. When they see caring volunteers helping beautify their home, that too improves their self esteem.

Agency to provide: Family Renew is willing to supply the necessary project materials; however we would welcome any and all donations. Coffee, juice and donuts in the morning, water and snacks, and lunch will be provided.
